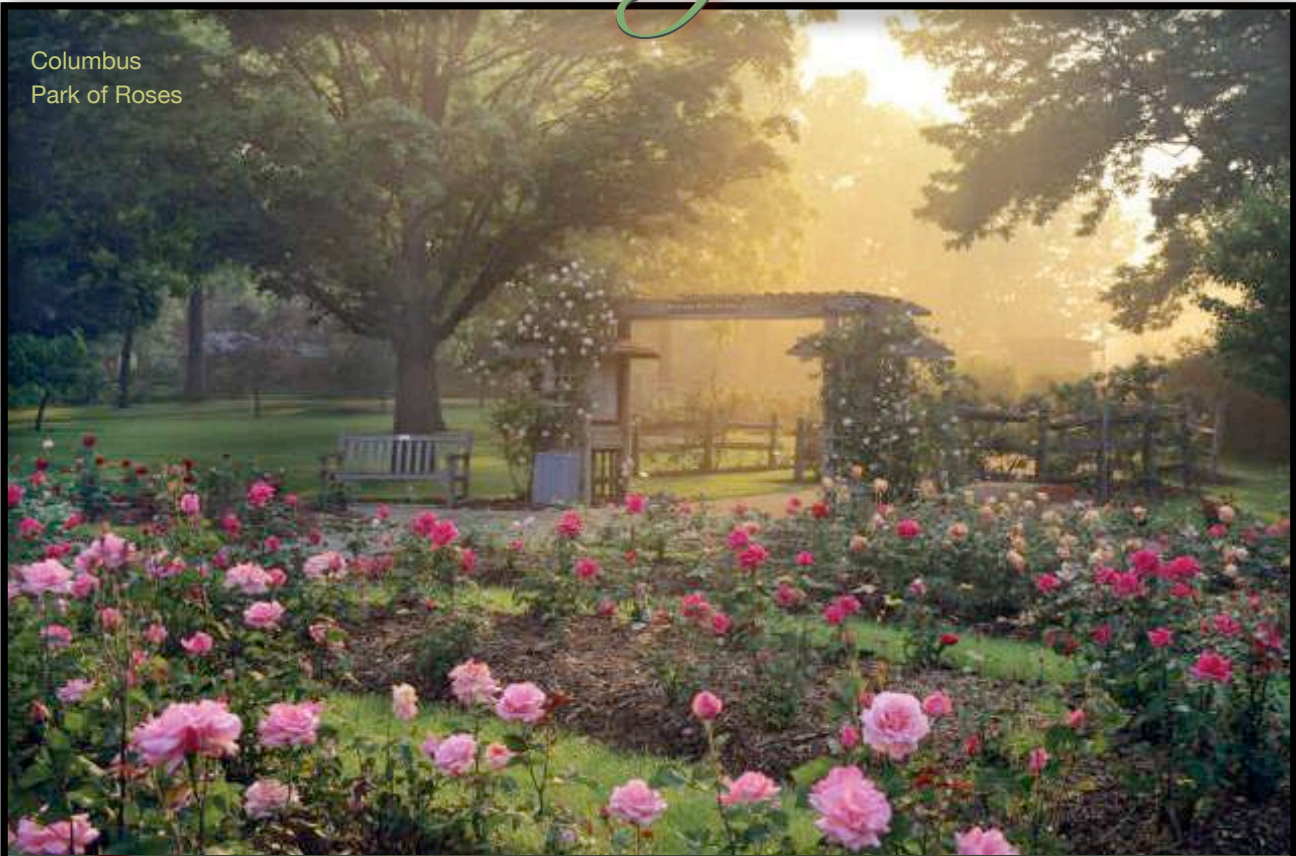

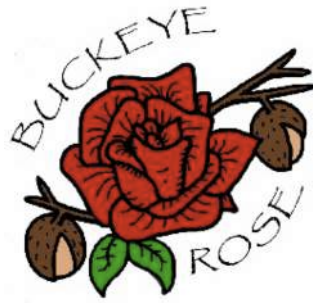

HORTICULTURAL SHOW RULES

Notes:

Horticulture Section A – Buckeye District Perpetual Challenge Awards are open to ARS Buckeye District Members ONLY. A correct and complete entry tag must be placed on each container. Challenge Class trophy winners are responsible to arrange and pay for the engraving of perpetual trophy(ies) and/or plaque(s) awarded to them and to return the trophy to the District Second Vice President or next show location the following year.

Horticulture Section B, Class 14 will be judged alphabetically. Each cultivar will be a separate sub-class.

Horticulture Sections F, G & H are Open only to Members of the Host Societies: the Delaware Area Rose Society, the Columbus Rose Club and the Lancaster Rose Club.

1. The rules and regulations of the American Rose Society for the exhibition of garden roses shall govern this show. The rules are detailed in Guidelines for Judging Roses, with current information and corrections published in the AMERICAN ROSE magazine. (Point scoring: Form 25; Color – 20; Stem & Foliage – 20; Substance – 15; Size – 10; Balance & proportion – 10.)

2. Every exhibitor must register and pay the registration fee to the Registration Committee. Any amateur is eligible to exhibit and need not be a member of any rose organization except as noted in special classes.

3. All entries, shall be received Sunday, September 21, 2014 from 7:30a.m. to 10:30 am. Judging will begin at 10:30 a.m. The show will be open to the public as soon as the judging is completed, estimated at 1:00 pm.

4. Exhibitors will present their entries to the Placement Committee and will not be permitted to approach the exhibits until judging is completed.

Exceptions: ARS National Trophy / District Perpetual Awards may be placed on the exhibition table by the exhibitor under the supervision of the Placement Committee and Arrangers MUST place their own arrangements in the designated areas.

5. Only judges, clerks, Rose Show Chairman and Arrangement Chairman are permitted within the show area during judging. Exhibitors not following this rule are subject to disqualification from the show. Any exceptions to this rule must be approved by the Rose Show Chairman.

6. Only American Rose Society entry tags shall be used. Both sections must be completed including section, class number, variety, name, address, and exhibitor number. Name labels or stamps and blue or black ink are permitted to be used on entry tags.

7. All Roses in specimen classes must be grown by the exhibitor or team of exhibitors in his/her outdoor, private garden. (one garden only).

8. Containers will be furnished for all classes except for: classes 28,29,35,36,43 and 44 which must be provided by the exhibitor.

9. Wedges of commonly accepted materials may be used, but must not extend above the top of the vase and must be used as inconspicuously as possible. A space must be left to allow watering of the entry.

10. Neither the Delaware Area Rose Society, the Columbus Rose Club, the Lancaster Rose Club, All Occasions Catering or the Buckeye District of the American Rose Society is responsible for the loss of or damage to exhibitor property or prizes or for injury to persons attending the show. Liability of all nature is disclaimed.

11. For specifications governing arrangements, refer to the rules listed in the Artistic Design Schedule section.

12. All rose varieties exhibited must be entered under the classification and the approved exhibition name of the American Rose Society as listed in Modern Roses XII, the American Rose Annual, the American Rose Magazine, ARS 2014 Official List of Approved Exhibition Names for Exhibitors & Judges, the Handbook for Selecting Roses or the Combined Rose List.

13. This is an alphabetical show. With the exception of challenge classes, all one stem entries in each class will be placed alphabetically and each variety in each class shall constitute a separate class.
 14. ARS Gold, Silver and Bronze Certificates will be awarded to Hybrid Tea/Grandiflora, Floribunda Spray, Miniature and Miniflora Queens, Kings and Princesses of the Show.
 15. Horticulture Division entries in violation of ARS or Show Rules shall be disqualified. Entries shall also be disqualified for the following reasons: Misnamed, misclassified, misplaced, unlabeled or mislabeled, stem-on-stem (except for OGRs and Shrubs), not disbudded, and presence of foreign substance applied to the foliage, stem or bloom to improve the appearance of the specimen.
 16. Keeper Trophies and ARS Certificates will be awarded on Sunday, September 21 at 4:45 p.m. in the Exhibit Room.
 17. All roses in separate containers must each have an entry tag, including challenge classes.
 18. Each exhibitor or team is entitled to one half (1/2) table space in prep area.
 19. All roses become the property of the show committee.

ARRANGEMENT SHOW RULES

1. The artistic division is open to anyone, except Classes 23 (for novices) and 24 (for judges of the show). Preregistration is required for Table Settings (Classes 25 and 26). Please pre-register your intent to exhibit in these classes by September 14, 2014. Send requests to: Lew Shupe, 1343 Sunset Drive, Fairborn, OH 45324-5649 (cell 937-478-4602) or e-mail: lewis.shupe@wright.edu. Other reservations are not required but in order to provide for adequate exhibit space, your intent to exhibit in specific classes would be appreciated.
 2. The arrangement preparation area will be open at 7:00 a.m. on Sunday morning. Arrangements are to be entered between 7:30 – 10:30 a.m. Judging will begin at 10:30 a.m. and will follow the ARS Guidelines for Judging Rose Arrangements. Arrangements are not to be removed until the closing of the show.
 3. The exhibit must be the sole work of the exhibitor(s) listed on the entry tag. An exhibitor is limited to one entry per class but may enter as many different classes as desired. Exhibitors are not to build the entire arrangement on the show floor, but should complete as much work as possible in the show preparation area prior to final arrangement placement. Mechanical and electrical special lighting are not permitted. Care will be taken for the protection of the exhibit; however, the host committee, the facility, and the Buckeye District of the ARS are not responsible for any loss or breakage.
 4. Exhibitors will place their own entries, but must not move another exhibitor's arrangement. If an arrangement needs to be moved, and if all efforts to locate the arranger have failed, the arrangement chairperson may move the arrangement.
 5. Standard size arrangements will be placed on a table with an approximate depth of 30" and 24" width. Because of varying dimensions of physical spaces in various facilities, arrangers should be flexible with these dimensions and plan their arrangements accordingly. Niches are not being used; therefore, arrangers may provide their own backdrops, that must fit into allotted spaces. Table coverings are neutral colored.
-

6. Miniature rose arrangements must not exceed 10” in height, width or depth, except in certain classes (as noted in the class descriptions). In some cases, the requirements may range from 5” to 12”. Niches are not provided; therefore, arrangers are encouraged to provide their own free-standing backdrops for their designs. Miniature exhibits will be judged at eye-level.

7. All roses must be outdoor grown, of high quality, and the dominant flowers in the arrangement. Names of all roses in the design must be listed on the entry tag. If the roses are arranger grown, “AG” should be written in the upper right hand corner of the entry tag (or with a check mark if AG is printed on the tag). Only “AG” entries are eligible for the ARS Gold, Silver and Bronze Certificates. A 3” x 5” card may be placed by the exhibit to aid in interpreting the theme, or to add educational information.

8. In addition to roses, other flowers and dried and/or treated plant materials are allowed unless prohibited and noted within the schedule’s classes. These are not permitted in any artistic arrangement: 1) painted or dyed fresh materials; 2) live creatures; 3) plant materials on state or local conservation lists; and 4) the flag of any country. Accessories are not allowed unless specifically noted within the class description. It is important to become familiar with the schedule, as each section, and the classes, have unique requirements.

9. To be eligible for an American Rose Society arrangement award, the exhibit must score 92 points or higher. To be eligible for a first place blue ribbon, an exhibit must score 90 points or above; a second place red ribbon requires 85 points minimum; and a third place yellow ribbon requires 80 points minimum.

10. Overall causes for disqualification: 1) roses are not outdoor grown; and 2) the use of artificial plant materials. If an arrangement is incorrectly placed, it will be judged in the class in which it has been placed.

11. The scorecard for judging rose arrangements is as follows:

Conformance – 15 points

(naming of roses; conformance to type of design; other requirements of schedule)

Design (5 points per principle of design) – 30 points
(balance; dominance; contrast; rhythm; proportion; scale)

Perfection of Roses – 30 points
(includes condition of other flowers and plant materials)

Creativity and Expressiveness – 15 points
(personal expression; relation to theme; artistic endeavor)

Distinction – 10 points
(uniqueness; sets the design apart; superiority in every aspect; includes technical execution and construction)

Total – 100 points
